1. Opening

We are to receive the Word of GOD by the Spirit, so I strongly urge you to pray before you receive the Devotional. Let Christ take the lead in your Spiritual Development.

Introduction

We will go straight into the Word today, no introductions.

2. Scripture Text

1 Timothy 2:1-6 KJV

[1] I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; [2] for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. [3] For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; [4] who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. [5] For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; [6] who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

3. Devotional Reflection

Surely, by now, you know how this works? Our main scripture comes from extending the Verse of the Day, and later, there will be an expansion from my Daily Reading. I have covered this chapter in the Sons in Faith series, but this section here (while the Verse of the Day alone has limited scope again) is for us to learn the truth of the Will of GOD.

What is the will of GOD?

Can we pray for one another, or rather, should we pray for one another? What about the grumpy all man you have to pass each day, should you pray for him? Is there grace for him at the Throne of GOD? Friends, remember where Christ is at this moment.

You know, the last couple of days (if not weeks) I have been weeping a great deal. Especially as we hit the moment of the message, "Minds made Up." The original purpose for the audio recordings of Notes like these, ceased with the passing of Aunty Linda, for whom they were done at first. But, how can I stop sharing this with others? The truth should be brought to all mankind, by the Will of GOD that we have just read about. How do we honour Jesus Christ, why would we be ashamed of His Name? I have looked around and I see something that is breaking

my heart, not even thinking how it lands at the Throne of GOD. How people under the banner of Christ are promoting other religions. Maybe, man has lost the Good Book, or at least the contents of it. Maybe, man has been so busy with his religion, that we forgot GOD.

I want to share a very interesting section of scripture with you today, about King Josiah, but read for yourself, here:

2 Kings 22:10-20 KJV

[10] And Shaphan the scribe shewed the king, saying, Hilkiyah the priest hath delivered me a book. And Shaphan read it before the king. [11] And it came to pass, when the king had heard the words of the book of the law, that he rent his clothes. [12] And the king commanded Hilkiyah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying, [13] Go ye, enquire of the LORD for me, and for the people, and for all Judah, concerning the words of this book that is found: for great is the wrath of the LORD that is kindled against us, because our fathers have not hearkened unto the words of this book, to do according unto all that which is written concerning us. [14] So Hilkiyah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; (now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;) and they communed with her. [15] And she said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Tell the man that sent you to me, [16] Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, and upon the inhabitants thereof, even all the words of the book which the king of Judah hath read: [17] because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched. [18] But to the king of Judah which sent you to enquire of the LORD, thus shall ye say to him, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, As touching the words which thou hast heard; [19] because thine heart was tender, and thou hast humbled thyself before the LORD, when thou heardest what I spake against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and hast rent thy clothes, and wept before me; I also have heard thee, saith the LORD. [20] Behold therefore, I will gather thee unto thy fathers, and thou shalt be gathered into thy grave in peace; and thine eyes shall not see all the evil which I will bring upon this place. And they brought the king word again.

Friends, they were tending the Temple, but they lost the Book of Law. They were standing in practice without the Word that established those rituals they performed at the House of GOD. And I look around me, and see people under the Banner of Jesus Christ, but they don't know the Father or the Son, they stand in practice, but do it for their own self. If you promote a blending of doctrines and religions, you have lost your way. Then you have lost the Good Book too, and you do not know its contents, else you would be weeping with me. Church has become something you do, like a social gathering of like minded people. Like minded, how?

What about the lost sheep? Who calls them? Has the Book of Law been abolished again, like the evil kings of Judah and Israel did, as they walk after false gods and idols. Are you in church for a feel good moment? Or, are you still open for correction, without being offended?

On the large part, bar a few, man has taken the reign out of the hands of Christ and are doing their own thing. Do you pray for your leaders or do you revolt in the street? And this includes revolting on social media as slanders are thrown around as if it is nothing in the sight of GOD.

Listen now, we must all repent. Hear these words in 1 Timothy 2. Hear the words of the prophetess in 2 Kings 22. There are curses attached to not walking in the ways of GOD, and those ways were made known first by the Law of Moses and then Jesus Christ came as the Word of GOD made flesh. Hear the Sermon on the mount, friends. Hear it! Hear the words of testimony of the Apostles of Jesus Christ. Hear it, and conform to it. Change your ways. The Word of GOD is not there to conform to you, you must conform to the Word of GOD, especially where you find yourself in a form of departure from it.

I know nobody wants to hear this, but it still remains true; time is running out for all of us. Many are abusing the time of grace, and will have no part in the redemption.
