A Promise of Peace, A Cry of Anguish

Did David Know?

For in his cries to GOD, we see the reply of GOD in Jesus Christ. See if you can see it. We're looking for indications of the Messiah. We're looking for the one that wasn't kept in the grave but escaped it. I want you to listen and hear to see that David did know.

The Evidence: Unjust Hatred & Rejection

The Prophecy (Psalm 69)

"They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head." (v. 4)

"I am become a stranger unto my brethren, And an alien unto my mother's children." (v. 8)

The Fulfillment (New Testament)

"But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause." (John 15:25)

"For neither did his brethren believe in him." (John 7:5)

The Evidence: Zeal for God's House

The Prophecy (Psalm 69)

"For the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up; and the reproaches of them that reproach thee are fallen upon me." (v. 9)

The Fulfillment (New Testament)

"And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up." (John 2:17)

"For even Christ pleased not himself; but, as it is written, The reproaches of them that reproached thee fell on me." (Romans 15:3)

The Evidence: The Bitter Cup of the Cross

The Prophecy (Psalm 69)

“Reproach hath broken my heart, and I am full of heaviness: and I looked for some to take pity, but there was none; and for comforters, but I found none.” (v. 20)

“They gave me also gall for my meat; And in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.” (v. 21)



The Fulfillment (New Testament)

“They gave him vinegar to drink mingled with gall...” (Matthew 27:34)



“...Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst.” (John 19:28)

The Verdict: David Knew



**The testimony of Jesus Christ
is the spirit of prophecy.**

- Revelation 19:10

In Psalm 69, David declares the Messiah. He testifies for Christ that would come from his bloodline. His own suffering became a vessel for a divine prophecy about his Lord and Savior.

A Warning Against a False Gospel

The World's Jesus



"This world sells a Jesus that never took up the whip... that forgives everything irrespective of your mindset and your heart again and again even when you are not truly repentant."

The Jesus of Scripture



"This one that we read of here in Psalm 69 who had zeal for the house of God... who overturned the tables of the money changers."

They don't preach about that.

The Posture of Faith: Performance vs. Repentance

Public Protest



“Why would you go and protest man when you can make all your wants and your needs known to God at the throne of God?... The fact that you’ve got to go and walk and dance in the street shows me that you do not trust God.”

David’s Humility



“Remember David before the Lord in victory? He didn’t dance before the Lord. He was flat on his face on the ground in sackcloth and ashes weeping... as we read here in Psalm 69.”

“O God, thou knowest my foolishness; and my sins are not hid from thee.” - Psalm 69:5

The Mandate: Get Into the Word

Get into the word of God. Get into the word of God before they remove it and you do not have access to it at all anymore. Get the word of God on your heart and in your mind.

We stand in a place where we will perish for a lack of knowledge. Just like Hosea said, we perish because we do not know the word of God.



The Mandate: Tithe Your Time

What the Lord reveals to me, he will reveal to each and every one of you if you seek his face.



The Practical Challenge

Instead of only dropping coins and notes into the church... How about you start tithing of your time? A tithe of your awakening time is about the length of a feature film. Around about an hour and a half.

The Countdown Has Begun

It's time to get serious about your faith because if your faith is not in a foundation, the world that is coming... is encroaching on us. It is creeping closer. It is in the shadows.

The initial installations of the core systems will be in place by less than a year... The only thing that we're waiting for is that one which they will call their champion and he will come in through flatteries.

It's not just another Thursday. It's a countdown of Thursdays towards the day of the Lord.

What Is Your Testimony?

The question that you've got to ask yourself today is whether you know if the Holy Spirit is guiding you in what is good and what is not.

Are you testifying for Christ, or are you testifying for this world?
